

HAMILTON SANTA CLAUS PARADE INFORMATION SHEET

DATE: Saturday November 13th, 2010

TIME: 1:30 PM – 3:30 PM Parade begins at 2pm

DROP OFF: We will be meeting at the Main Entrance to Sir John A MacDonald School (map on the back) which is located at the intersections of Bay Street and York Boulevard no later than 1:30 pm. The school should be open so that the children can use the washroom before we get on the float if needed. We have been informed that the parade will be approximately 90 minutes in duration. (Look for our float, we do not know position yet)

PICK UP: We are asking that all parents meet us back at the Main Entrance to Sir John A MacDonald School at 3:30 pm to pick up their child after they get off the float.

We will have cell phones with us on Saturday. The numbers are 416-428-4200 (Andy) or 905-906-9693 (Pam). Please call if you will be late dropping off or picking up your child.

Please keep an eye on the weather for Saturday and dress your child appropriately. Everyone should have their neckerchief on over top of their coat. If your child has a Santa Claus hat or reindeer ears, etc, your child is more than welcome to wear it.

If your child has a campfire blanket they can bring it to wear on the float as well which will help him or her to stay warm.

Please ensure you stress to your children (Beavers and Cubs) that they will be on a moving vehicle and **MUST** remain seated for the duration of the parade for their own safety.


This is the third year that 1st Binbrook will be participating in the Santa Claus Parade and we hope that everyone has a wonderful time.
