Please USE the lists, and be prepared!

Patrols/Scouts will have the <u>option</u> of carrying all gear with them, or simply carrying a daypack with necessities, and their gear meeting them at the campsite. Either way is just fine, and the participants that do so in past years, are usually 50-50. *(although... to challenge for the trophy, they have to carry it all...)*

Each Patrol of Scouts will need to have one cell phone between them, if you can borrow/commit one. It will be for check-in purposes only, and if costs are an issue, please discuss. Trails are well guided by adults as well.

If you have need to borrow any gear, please call, and we can discuss what we have available in our loaner cupboard. Backpacks, foam pads, etc. We will bring spares/loaner gear to meeting just before camp.
